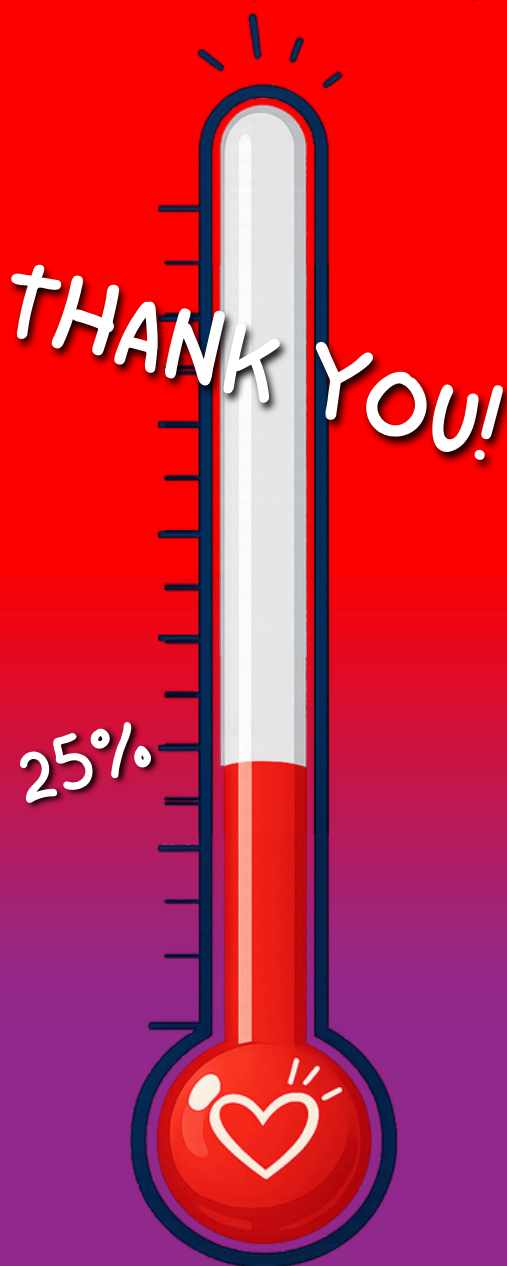


CAVE CREEK RODEO DAYS PARADE

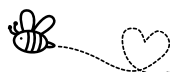

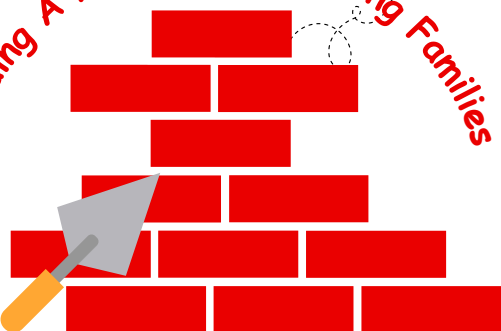
